what is the Leisure Tourism Database?

Updated weekly, the database supplies bibliographic information and abstracts for all aspects of leisure and tourism, including policy and planning, education and training, travel, sports, hospitality, the arts and entertainment. The natural environment and ecotourism, recreational activities and cultural heritage are key areas covered by the resource.

The Leisure Tourism database (a subset of CAB Abstracts) contains:

- over 158,000 research summaries covering the last 40 years, sourced from over 6,000 serial publications, plus books, reports and conference proceedings
- weekly updates, with over 32,000 new records added in the past three years
- literature from all over the world (84 countries)
- records taken from over 3,600 serials in 2015
- over 5,900 full text records (plus over 2,000 eBooks and chapters)
