

CABI FREE IDENTIFICATION SERVICE FOR MEMBER COUNTRIES

As part of Member Country benefits, a **free service** is available from the Microbial Identification Service, based at CABI UK, **for identification of plant pathogenic fungi and bacteria that are causing disease to agricultural crops including those detected in quarantine.** This service is available to CABI Member Countries in bands 1-4 (i.e. those with a UN Index Number between 0 - 0.999).

Organisations eligible to benefit from the free service are:

- National and Regional Agricultural Research Centres
- Government Institutions responsible for agriculture and food security
- University Departments whose studies relate to agricultural research

A maximum of 10 samples per institution may be submitted each year, with a maximum of 40 free identifications available to each Member Country per year.
