Purpose of the role:

The Instructional Designer will lead the development and implementation of e-learning plant health training modules based on existing face-to-face training content. The job holder will be expected to lead the design and production of the e-learning training, working in conjunction with a wide-range of stakeholders, particularly internal subject-matter experts and external developers.

Key accountabilities:

- Lead on collaboration with staff, freelance designers and team members to develop a cohesive user interface based on identified target audience's training needs
- Work closely with external e-learning developers to produce the final product
- Develop and write innovative and interactive learning content to meet functional learning objectives in eLearning environments, applying tested instructional design theories, practices and methods
- Build appropriate assessment instruments to judge learners' performance
- Suggest and implement new and innovative solutions for the delivery of online training and support
- Responsible for creation of supporting material/media (audio, video, simulations, games etc.)
- Ensure functionality within the selected Learning Management System (LMS) and authoring tool
- Manage and maintain project documentation
- Undertake and ensure testing and quality assurance of final product
