

Abbenes, near Amsterdam, the Netherlands managed by Jasper Roubos

History

Founded around 1870. In 2002, the farm was relocated a few kilometers to its current location, because of the construction of the high speed train track. In 2011, Jasper took over from his father Jan Roubos

Soil


The clay soil has no stones, good drainage and is not very susceptible to drought, leading to high fertility and high yield potential

Winter wheat, potato, onion, sugar beet

SEEDS

Good and certified seed is essential for a good yield.

BAYER SEEDGROWTH™

Integrated program aimed at sustainable seed and planting treatment and application technology.

CROP PROTECTION

Combined use of chemical and biological crop protection products for a sustainable production of healthy food.

PRECISION AGRICULTURE

Sustainable and efficient use of crop protection products with very targeted dosing.

DECISION SUPPORTING SYSTEMS

Integrated information about weather conditions and disease and pest warnings in order to use crop protection at the optimum time.

BIODIVERSITY

The added value of biodiversity for farmers, the environment and society.

PERSONAL PROTECTION

Protecting the user of crop protection products with technology such as easyFlow and Bayer DressCode.

EASYFLOW

Avoiding exposure of the user and the environment to concentrated products by using a closed transfer system during the filling of the sprayer.

BEE HEALTH

Supporting bee health through pest control, enhancement of biodiversity and careful use of crop protection products.

FARMYARD EMISSION

Prevent emission from the farmyard, with techniques like a dedicated cleaning place combined with a Phytobac®.

EMISSION THROUGH RUN OFF

Prevent run off of applied crop protection products and fertilizers to surface water by plot design and special cultivation techniques.

Where: the Netherlands

Challenge: first hand access to information about innovative potato production solutions

What did we do?

- Tour around 'the Netherlands' excellence center of potato production' to major value chain stakeholders the Wageningen Research, Tolsma (storage facility company) and Grimme (machinery producer).
- Focus training on potato agronomy, emphasizing on the role of disease and pest management during the crop growth and storage period.
- Introduction of potato production technologies, value-adding services and sustainable farming practices (e.g. BayG.A.P. farmer training tool, stewardship and biodiversity measures) at the Bayer Forward Farm in Abbenes, NL.




