Maturity 25–50 days

Winter Radish
Sold as individual roots
Maturity is greater than 50 days

Icicle

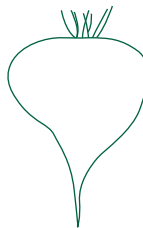

Used primarily fresh



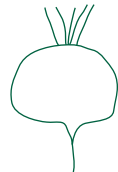
