- Create and work on projects
- Highlight and annotate records
- Save records and searches, and set up alerts

NEW – organise your work with My Projects

The new **My Projects** feature of CAB Direct is efficient and convenient. It allows you to create an unlimited number of projects to help you efficiently organise your searches and records.

- Create projects to manage your literature reviews
- Group and organise your records and searches quickly and efficiently

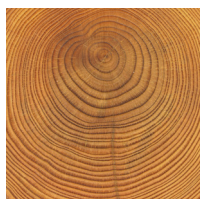
