What is the CABI BioProtection Portal?

The CABI BioProtection Portal is an online tool that helps growers and agricultural advisors to identify, source and correctly apply biocontrol and biopesticide products against pests in their crops. The portal is free to use and can be accessed on multiple devices, thereby putting this valuable information at the fingertips of anyone who needs it.



How does the CABI BioProtection Portal work?

- 1. Users enter their country and croppest query.
- 2. The search generates a list of biocontrol and biopesticide products, together with their active ingredient and manufacturer/ registrant, that are registered for the specified crop-pest problem in the selected country. This information
- is sourced directly from national governments' lists of registered plant protection products.
- 3. Further guidance on correct storage and application is also provided for products that belong to partner biocontrol manufacturers, together with links to product labels and distributor details.

Who is the CABI BioProtection Portal for?

- Growers and advisors who need current and reliable information on-demand regarding the availability and correct use of effective, lower toxicity products that meet market requirements
- National authorities responsible for the regulation of plant protection products
- Private sector decision-makers, e.g. out-grower schemes, cooperatives, organisations operating voluntary certification schemes
- Biocontrol manufacturers who are looking to promote wider uptake of their products

The CABI BioProtection Portal roadmap

The portal was launched in Kenya in February 2020 and is now live in 14 countries. More countries are in the pipeline - look at https://bioprotectionportal.com/roadmap for more details.
