CABI: publishing books of quality and range


- When your book is published by CABI, you can be assured that it will be part of a publishing programme of the highest quality.




CABI: the best publishing services

- When you publish your book with CABI, you can expect the very best of author care from our dedicated team of publishing professionals. You will be treated as an individual and given the attention you deserve. As our author, you will be consulted every step of the way.
- Your subject-specialist Commissioning Editor will help you with your book proposal, organize peer review and be on hand to advise you throughout the writing period.
- Once you have submitted your completed manuscript to us it will be assigned to a member of our expert book production team. Your Production Editor will be in contact with you throughout the production process.
- Your manuscript will be edited by a subject-specialist copy-editor.
- Your Production Editor will arrange typesetting and proofreading, and the production of the index for your book by a professional indexer.
- Finally, your book will be published in both print and eBook formats.
 We publish most of our print books as hardbacks initially and in paperback after 3 years. The majority of our books are also made available electronically in the CAB eBook collection, and chapter abstracts are included in our CAB Abstracts database.
- We also offer an Open Access book publishing service through CABI Open Books. Please visit www.cabi.org/publishing-products/cabi-openbooks for details.
- Four years after publication our books are deposited in the FAO Research4Life collections allowing free or very low-cost access to readers in developing countries.

- As a global organization, we have an international distribution network with channels to market your book to its target audience worldwide.
- Information about your book will be sent to existing customers, institutions and libraries, and members of relevant societies. Your book will also be included in our annual books catalogue, subject brochures and relevant cluster leaflets.
- Email alerts advertising your book will be sent to individuals registered on our extensive in-house mailing list.
- We exhibit our books at many major international conferences throughout the year and also advertise online, and via posters, leaflets and delegate packs.
- We'll work on the metadata and search engine optimisation of your book so that it is seen by the right people. We will send your book for review in the relevant journals and provide inspection copies of textbooks for active lecturers.
- Your book will receive active social media promotion to the relevant communities through our blogs and social media campaigns.
