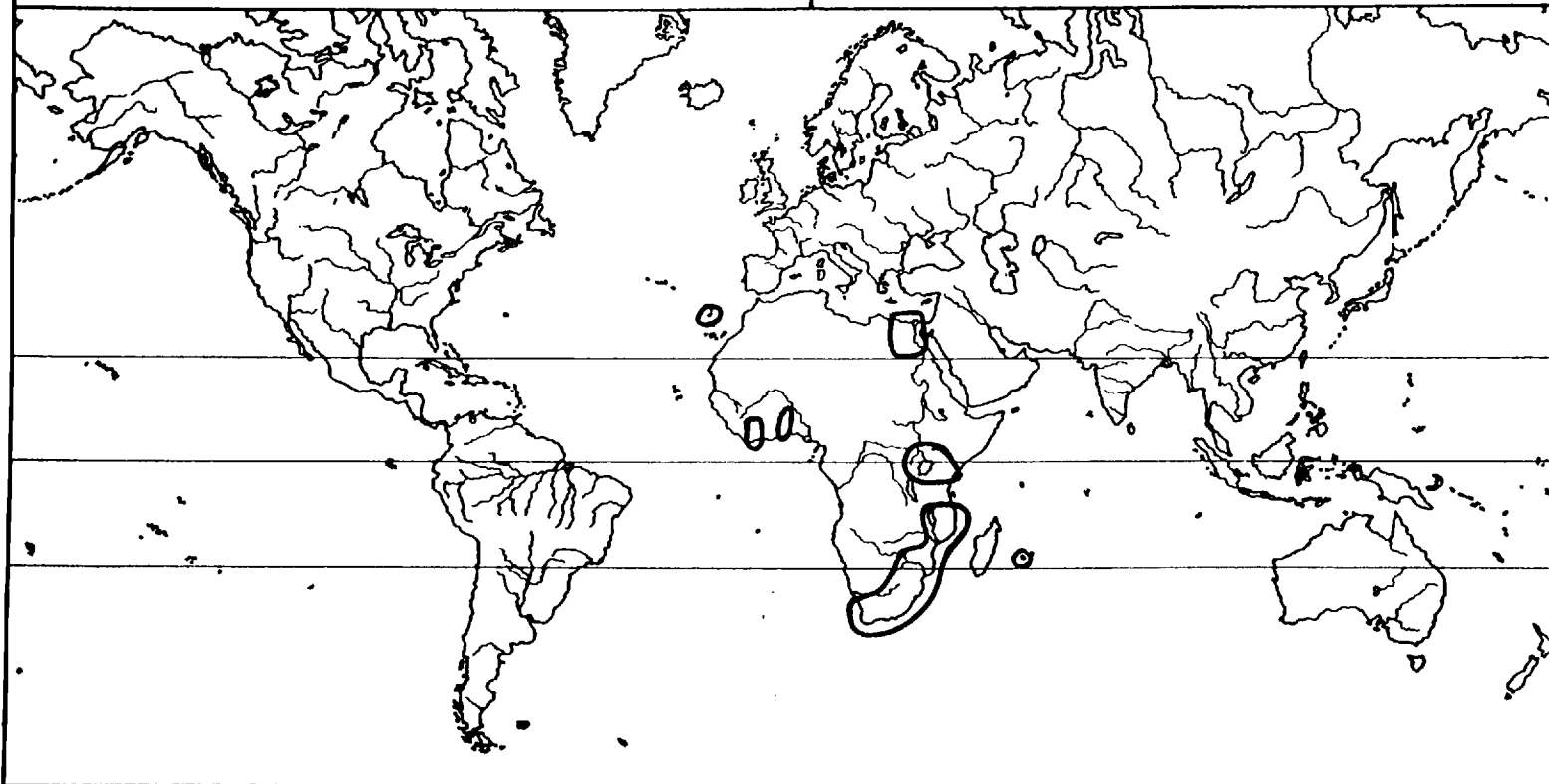
DISTRIBUTION MAPS OF PLANT DISEASES
