

A record for Algeria in Ben-Dov (1994) was based on a misinterpretation of Balachowsky (1926), which mentions the threat to Algeria posed by *M. hirsutus*. This record was incorrectly given in the previous edition of this map. The record for Guatemala in Watson and Chandler (2000) was an error; no evidence has been seen to indicate its presence there (Watson, 2001). The first description of the species, as *Phenacoccus hirsutus* (Green, 1908) included material from Tasmania, Australia, but this is now regarded as a separate species, *M. tasmaniae* (Williams, 1985).
