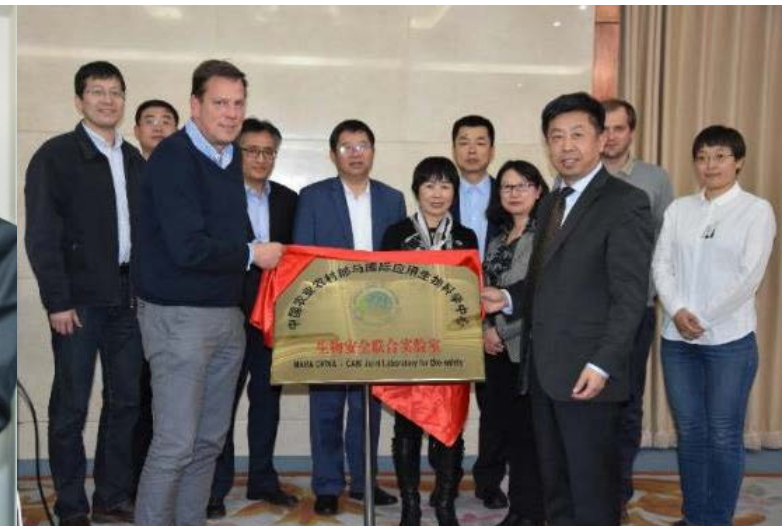

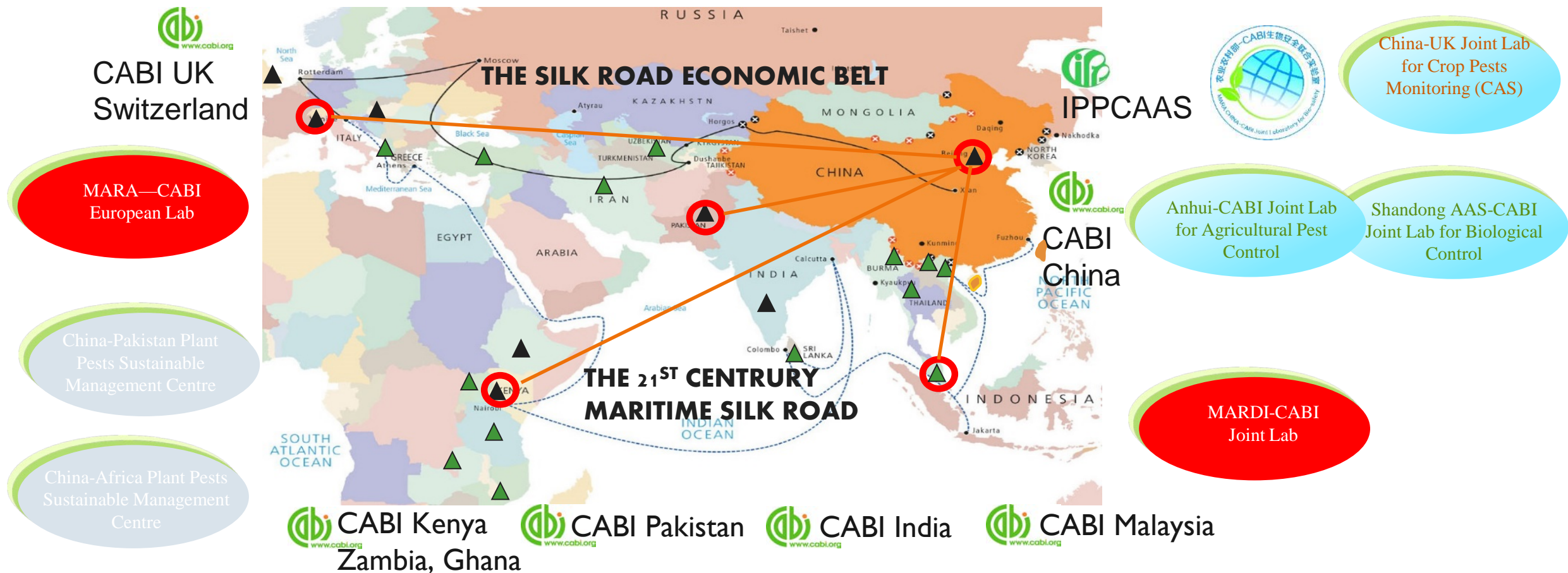

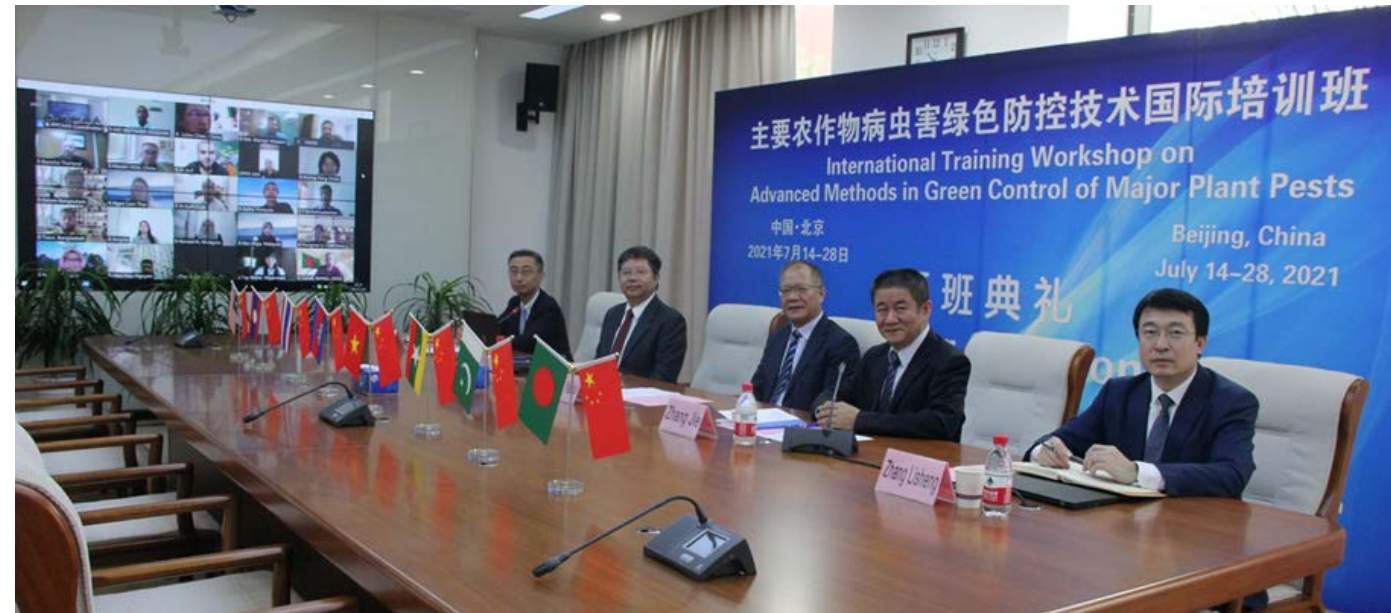

Prospects for Future Collaboration between China and CABI

- Optimize functions and expand global network of **the MARA-CABI Joint Lab and MARA-CABI European Lab** platforms, e.g .exploration of synergy with **MARDI-CABI Joint Lab** in Malaysia.
- Promote **South-South Cooperation** on technology transfer and training of green agriculture techniques between China and other member countries.
- Draw common interests and **develop inter-regional programs** together with CABI and its member countries in Asia-Pacific and other regions.
- Get CABI and its member countries more involved in the **International Science & Technology Innovation Programme of CAAS** (CAASTIP), e.g. sustainable management of transboundary crop pests.
- Expand cooperation in agricultural **information and knowledge sharing**.
