



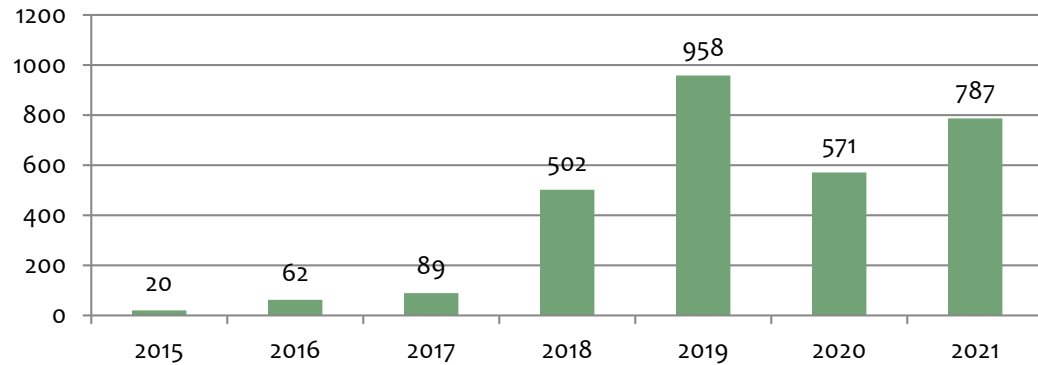

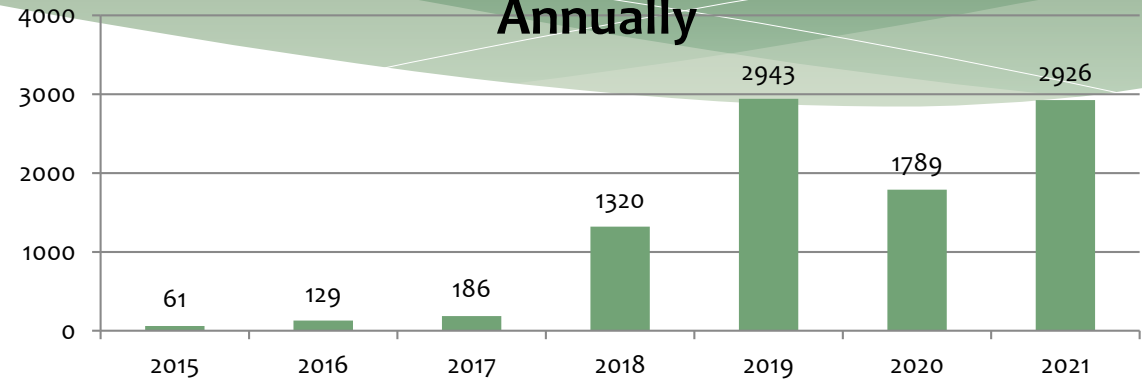
# PLANTWISE PLANT DOCTOR PROGRAMME FOR JAMAICA/ HIGHLIGHTS

- ❖ PROGRAMME STARTED IN 2015 (MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES)
- ❖ IMPLEMENTED BY THE RURAL AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (RADA), EXTENSION ARM OF THE MINISTRY. RADA PROVIDES EXTENSION SERVICES TO OVER 240,000 REGISTERED FARMERS ISLANDWIDE
- ❖ PLANT DOCTOR PROGRAMME IS INTEGRATED INTO THE JAMAICA'S PLANT HEALTH SYSTEM (EXTENSION-RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT AND PLANT QUARANTINE)
- ❖ ALL ASPECTS OF THE PROGRAMME ARE WITHIN PLANT HEALTH SYSTEM (DATA MANAGERS, TOTs; PDs; MONITORING & EVALUATION)
- ❖ OVER 130 AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION OFFICERS TRAINED AS PLANT DOCTORS
- ❖ SINCE 2019 RADA MAINSTREAMED MOBILE PLANT DOCTOR CLINICS (MOBILE APP), ADMINISTERED DURING REGULAR EXTENSION FARM VISITS
- ❖ OTHER ELEMENTS OF THE PD PROGRAMME IN JAMAICA INCLUDE:
  - (I) TOTs (TEAM FROM EXTENSION/ PLANT QUARANTINE AND R&D)
  - (II) DATA MANAGEMENT
  - (II) KNOWLEDGE BANK
  - (III) FIXED PLANT DOCTOR CLINICS
  - (IV) PLANT HEALTH RALLIES
  - (IV) ENGAGEMENT OF AGRICULTURAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (CASE);
  - (V) PD CLINICS FORMALLY INTEGRATED INTO THE RADA CORPORATE PLANNING (TARGETS AND OUTPUTS ARE SET FOR PLANT DOCTORS)

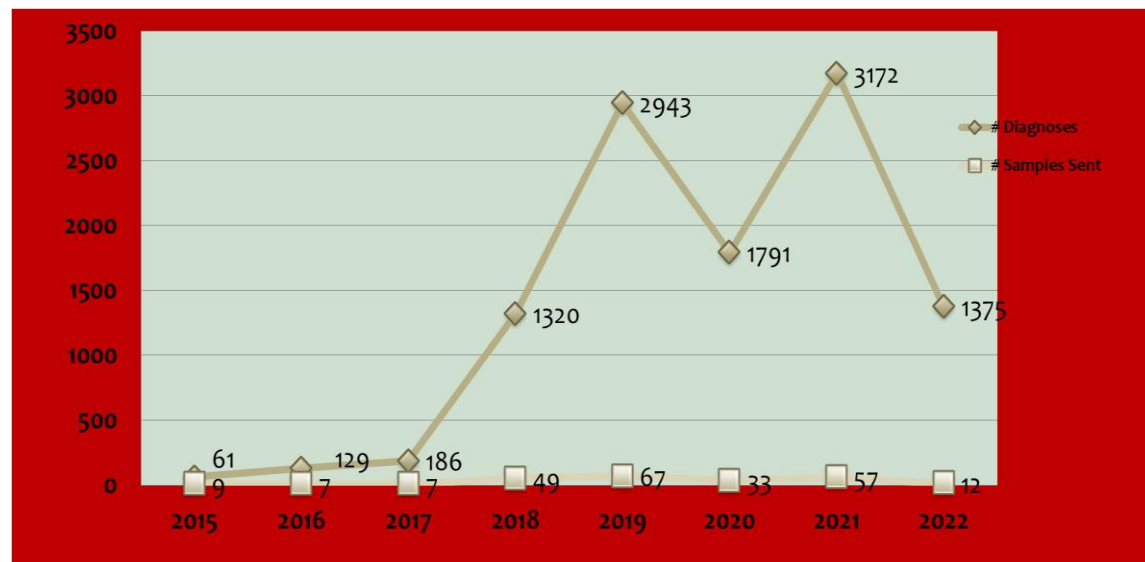
## No. Clinics Run Annually



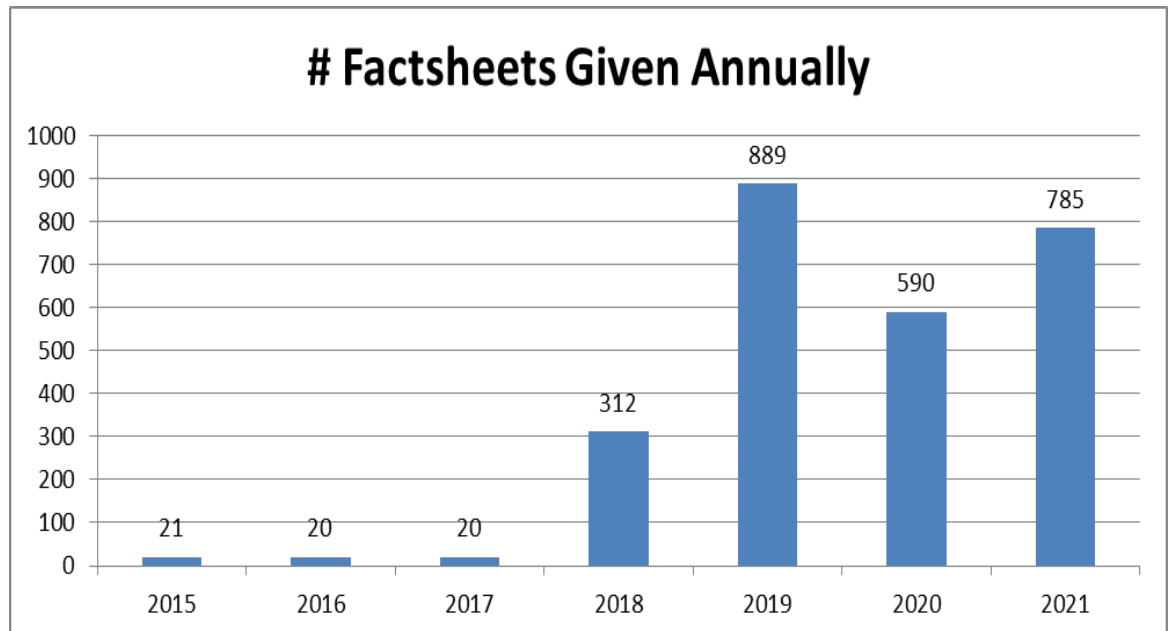
## No. Prescriptions/Queries Completed Annually
