- over 225,000 research summaries (derived from CAB Abstracts) covering the last 40 years, sourced from over 6,000 serial publications, plus books, reports and conference proceedings
- key topical subject areas include sustainable tourism, tourism and climate change, management of growth, and active recreation
- literature from all over the world
- over 12,500 full text records
- over 2,850 eBook chapters from over 170 complete eBooks
- over 4,500 open access news and review articles
