# Themes and Questions (1)

## Prompts

- Do the different roles of Liaison Officers and Executive Council Members and their split of responsibilities work?
- Are there any ideas you would suggest to improve the way CABI interacts with its Member Countries?
- Is there anything we can learn from other Membership-based organisations?

## Themes and Questions (2)

### How to ensure that your countries get the broadest possible benefit from CABI membership

#### Prompts

- How can CABI work with Liaison Officers to gain more visibility and recognition of the work CABI does with you and with other partners in your country?
- What else could Liaison Officers do in brokering new links between CABI and other stakeholders in your country?

## Themes and Questions (3)

### Explore ways to increase collaborations between MCs involving CABI

#### Prompts

- Do you see any opportunities for more collaboration among Member Countries involving/through CABI?
- What types of joint projects, funding mechanisms, or resource-sharing models could maximize the collective impact of MCs and CABI?
- How could CABI work with Members to sustain/build on the value of development cooperation investments being discontinued due to ODA cuts or reallocations?

## Themes and Questions (4)

### Explore ways of delivering the Sustainable Development Goals in the face of changing ODA support

#### Prompts

- What does CABI need to change to adapt to your new needs as ODA levels and allocations change?
- Thinking from a CABI perspective, how would you advise us to sustain our impact in the new development/funding landscape?
