## Session aim

- To understand the perspective of growers and industry and explore the challenges and opportunities they face in implementing practices relating to pesticide risk reduction.

## Session description

# Reducing reliance on pesticides

- Do you think there is a good understanding of the **extent to which pesticides are used** within your sector? If yes, is this through surveys, monitoring schemes etc?
- Do you have **policies or frameworks** that encourage Integrated Pest Management in your sector/industry? To what extent do the policies and frameworks influence farming practices in the region/your sector? What are the **challenges to implementing these policies/approaches** at farm level?





# Access and availability of lower risk plant protection products

- What do you think the **knowledge level** relating to **using bioprotection products or Integrated Pest Management** is in your sector/industry?
- Do you think **lower risk plant protection products (including biological control agents)** are **easily accessible by farmers**? Do you think the advice on their use is sufficient?



# Ensuring proper use of the selected products

- Who is responsible for **ensuring the proper use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)** by farmers while applying pesticides? Are there education and awareness campaigns? Where are the challenges associated with the use of PPE?
- Is there **awareness around how to dispose of plant protection products safely**? Are there mechanisms in place to encourage responsible disposal of used pesticide containers?
